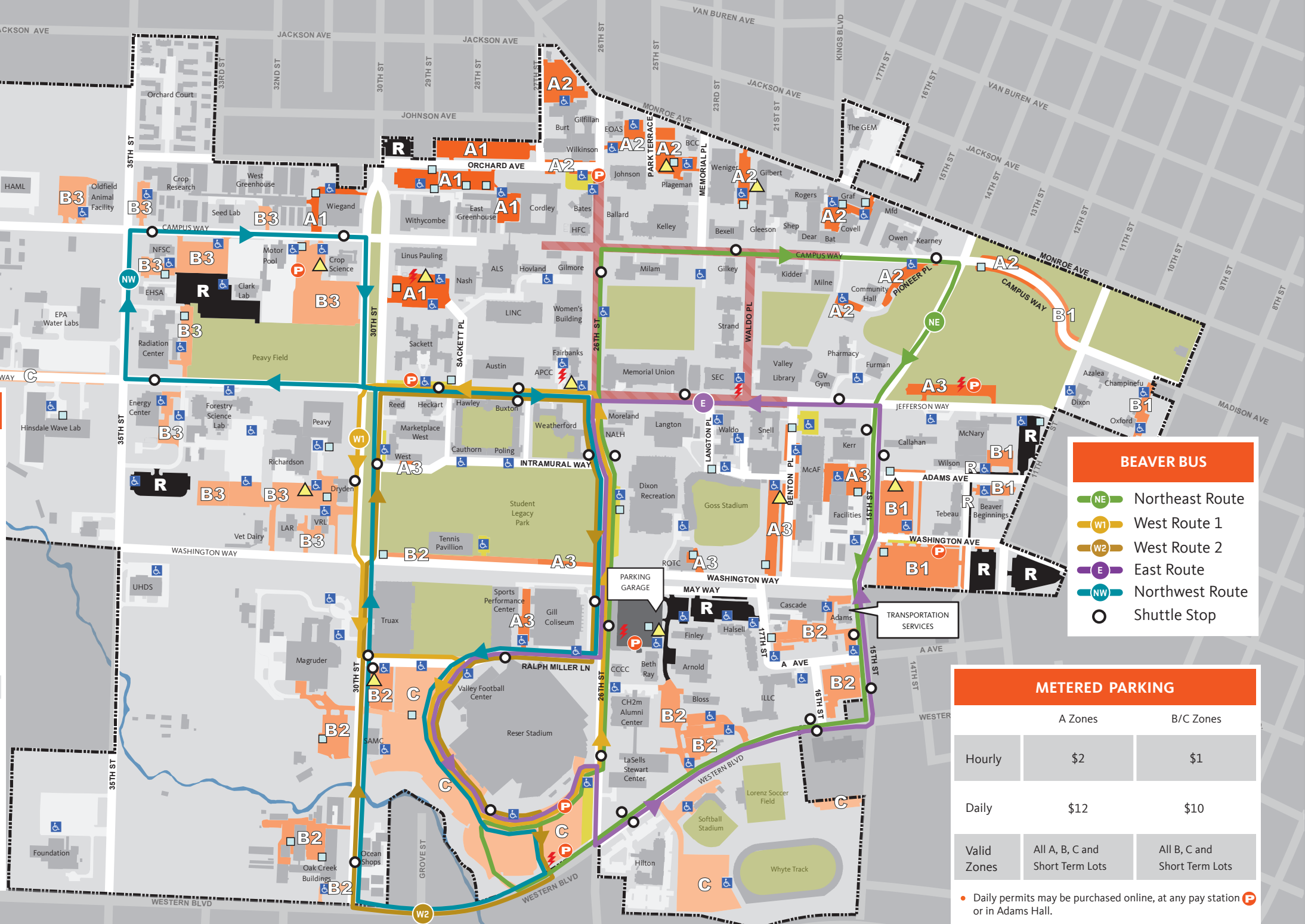

## PARKING ON CAMPUS

Parking permits are required for all motorized vehicles on campus, unless otherwise specified by signage.

Citations may be issued to vehicles not clearly displaying a valid permit.

All vehicles must be parked in marked spaces.

Vehicle parking at OSU is governed by University Standard 07-025, and Oregon revised Statute 352.087(1).

## PERMIT HOURS

Permits are required year-round.

- Commuter zone (A, B and C) lots require permits Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Resident zone (R) lots require permits at all times.
- Metered parking: Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

## DID YOU KNOW?

- OSU parking operations are completely self-funded, and are not supported by tuition, student fees or taxes. Permit fees support the construction, maintenance and management of parking facilities.
- Transportation Services staff will provide a free jump start to your vehicle on campus between 7 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Call us during business hours, and we can usually assist you within 15 minutes.
- Our field staff watch out for vehicles with lights left on, flat tires or anything else out of the ordinary and contact the vehicle owner.

## VISITOR PARKING

Visitors may purchase daily permits at pay stations on campus (locations on map), at our office in Adams Hall or online at [parking.oregonstate.edu](http://parking.oregonstate.edu)

Permits are not required on weekends and University-recognized holidays. **Permits are not valid at meters.**

Meter parking can be paid with coins or through the Passport Parking app. Details are posted on each meter.
